

# Settler District 4-H Scholarship Society

## Guidelines for Scholarship Application

1. Applicants for the 4-H Scholarship(s) must be present or past 4-H members.
2. The applicant must be enrolled in any Post Secondary Education.
3. The applicant must have an average of at least 60 per cent in the subjects taken in his/her last complete year of high school.
4. The applicant must have at least a Treasury Branch Gold Medal on his/her 4-H diary.
5. The applicant must submit two letters of recommendation from:
  - (a) An adult involved in the 4-H movement, and who is familiar with the applicant's participation in 4-H.
  - (b) One other adult who has known the applicant for at least two years. (Letters should not be from family members.)
6. The application deadline will be **November 30<sup>th</sup>**.
7. All applications will be considered and selected candidates will be invited to an interview. The scholarship(s) will be awarded on the basis of:

4-H diary	60%
Interview	35%
Letters of recommendation	5%

### **The following documents must be presented together at the time of application:**

- All 4-H Diaries
- Transcripts of high school marks
- Proof of enrolment in Post Secondary Education
- Two letters of recommendation
- Completed application form signed and dated

At least one scholarship of \$500 per year will be awarded.
