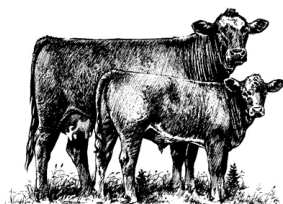

## 2020 NE 4-H Region Beef Show Rules:

1. Female projects must have registered with club, district and region by Jan.1 2020. This will be verified at the Regional Office at time of entries.
2. Members must be in "Good Standing" in club.
3. Animals must be unloaded at the assigned doors, not in parking lot. Indoor stalls are available for cattle. All cattle must have neck ropes.
4. Members encouraged to bring portable generators, chutes, blowers and all grooming supplies. The Ag Society has wash racks available. Please leave dogs at home.
5. Unruly animals will be stalled in a safe area, and the member will be given a chance to prove they can handle the animal. If animal is deemed dangerous NE 4-H Region Beef Show Committee decision will be final with safety a priority for everyone.
6. No parental involvement will be tolerated, except helping to halter, lead or hold for member, Parents are allowed in safety situations. We encourage ONLY 4-H members to help each other out.
7. No one allowed to leave until arena, wash area and grounds are clean.
8. Members and Parents are encouraged to interact with others to learn, encourage and have a fun filled day. There are several volunteer opportunities, please ask show committee.
9. Conformation classes will be divided according to age from youngest to oldest of the heifers and splits will be made at close of entry.
10. Beef Quiz, Grooming, Judging, Marketing and Showmanship will be divided according to Junior, Intermediate and Senior age groups.
11. Team Grooming will be made up of age categories with teams of 3 members. Members will be notified of teams prior to class.
12. Marketing class will focus on creativity and sales pitch.  
*Criteria for judging will be:*

<i>Creativity of the Item</i>		<i>20 points</i>
<i>Sales Pitch</i>	<i>Introduction</i>	<i>5 points</i>
	<i>Content (Knowledge, Messaging)</i>	<i>15 points</i>
	<i>Close of Sale</i>	<i>5 points</i>
	<i>Answers Questions from Judges</i>	<i>5 points</i>
	<i>Confidence/ Overall Impression</i>	<i>10 points</i>
13. Senior Cattlemen Achievement Award (**Deadline May 29, 2020**). Criteria included in the entry information that members can obtain from the Regional Specialist or at time of online registration.
14. Herd Award is defined as a yearling, 2 and 3-year old cows with calves at side. If at the time of entry there are no members with the required three projects, the Herd Award will be judge as a "Yearling with a cow-calf pair (either 2 or 3-year old with calf at side)".
15. Beef Aggregate - Junior, Intermediate and Senior Aggregate winners will be recognized. To be eligible for the beef aggregate award members must participate in the six (6) MANDATORY classes at the NE 4-H Region Beef Show.

A Jr. (14 yrs. & under) and Sr. (15 yrs. & older) Aggregate winner may be eligible to compete at the **2020 Western Canadian All Breeds Competition** at Bashaw, AB in August.
